## Acts 6:1-7

## Getting started:

- 1. Who are the Hellenists?
- 2. So—an unresolved conflict has arisen in the 'infant Church'—(didn't take too long did it?). What is at the heart of the conflict according to verse1?
- 3. Who are the 12? See Acts 1:26
- 4. Who are 'the full number of disciples'.
- 5. Who do you think might have been speaking in verse 2?
- 6. According to 'Peter'—what had the apostles been doing?
- 7. What was the solution (this is the key to answering our question) offered by the speaker?
- 8. What are the seven to be doing? Are there any qualifications for this work according to the text?
- 9. What then are the apostles to be doing?
- 10. Does it appear to you that the speaker is suggesting that one group is more holy or has a higher status in the Church than the other?
- 11. What kind of relationship do you see developing between these two 'offices'? Verse 5 and 6.
- 12. Has the unresolved conflict now become a 'resolved' conflict? How do we know.
- 13. What was the result of resolving the conflict? Verse 7.
- 14. Do you get the sense that these two entities will be working together in the future?
- 15. There's always a danger lurking when we work in different groups. What is that danger do you think?
- 16. How would we avoid those kinds of danger?

Note: It would take more time than we have to go deeply into Luther's incredible 2 Kingdom theology. But we can see those two kingdoms in Acts 6.
